ISSUING OF VOTING DOCUMENTS

Voting documents will be posted to electors from Friday 17 September 2010.

RETURN OF VOTING DOCUMENTS

Voting documents must be returned not later than 12 noon, Saturday 9 October 2010 to the electoral officer or an electoral official.

Special voting in terms of the Local Electoral Act 2001 and the Local Electoral Regulations 2001 may be exercised at the above council offices and times.

A person can apply to enrol as either a residential or ratepayer elector right up to and including 8 October 2010 – the day before the close of voting.

EARLY PROCESSING OF VOTING DOCUMENTS

The above district health boards have each resolved under section 79 of the Local Electoral Act 2001 to process voting documents before the close of voting.
